

An Update from Session on the Transition

Since the last issue of *The Grapevine* there has been a lot of change at our church. The session, presbytery, and Rev. Griff Gatewood decided we should dissolve our relationship and the congregation voted on April 24 to approve the terms of Griff's severance package. So, what happens now?

After worship on April 24, the session met with Tom Nesbit from the presbytery who will help the session and our congregation navigate through this next phase. The session has the option of hiring guest ministers through pastoral supply or immediately searching for an interim minister who will help guide us in the final step of finding a new minister.

Because the financial team is still working to get a clear picture of our financial situation, session has opted to utilize pastoral supply until we can determine what we can afford to pay an interim. Keep in mind that we are paying Griff's full salary for the next six months as part of his severance.

The presbytery recommends using an interim minister to guide us in our search for a full-time minister as we examine the wants and needs of our church. Those who were members eight years ago will remember activities such as a congregation health survey, and meeting in small groups to share our thoughts and hopes for our church's future.

Please pray for our church during this transition. We understand that this is a confusing time for our congregation. Session members are available to discuss where we are in our transition. Please pray for us as we navigate our next step in the process. All members of our congregation are welcome to attend session meetings, but some matters such as personnel must take place in closed session.

Through this process, we remain a loving and caring body of Christ. If there are any pastoral needs, please call the church office or any elder, and we will make sure you receive the care you need.
